Supporting access to training and qualification of people with disabilities through development of VET course on Ecological Vegetable Gardening based on ECVET learning outcomes

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Main aims:

- To improve the (pre-) qualification of long-term unemployed people (including those with disabilities) who have similar existing educational background in the field of gardening, seeds and crop fields and would like further to extend it.
- To develop and approbate a new occupational profile of "Eco-vegetable gardening worker", related curriculum, training modules and (pre-, post- and self) assessment mechanisms.
- To set up and implement guidelines for social entrepreneurship possibilities;
- To offer a sustainable employment of the people with disabilities.

Following products will be developed:

- I01: "Train the trainer" - Curriculum and training handbook on provision of ecological (organic) vegetable gardening training (ECVET based) for VET trainer/teachers
- I02: Training course on ecological vegetable gardening (ECVET based) for the students with learning disabilities

- I04: Social entrepreneurship skills guidelines
- I05: Ecological (organic) Vegetable Gardening Worker
- I06: Accessible mobile learning application for Android devices
